Use of oral anticoagulation in other clinical settings will also be touched upon.

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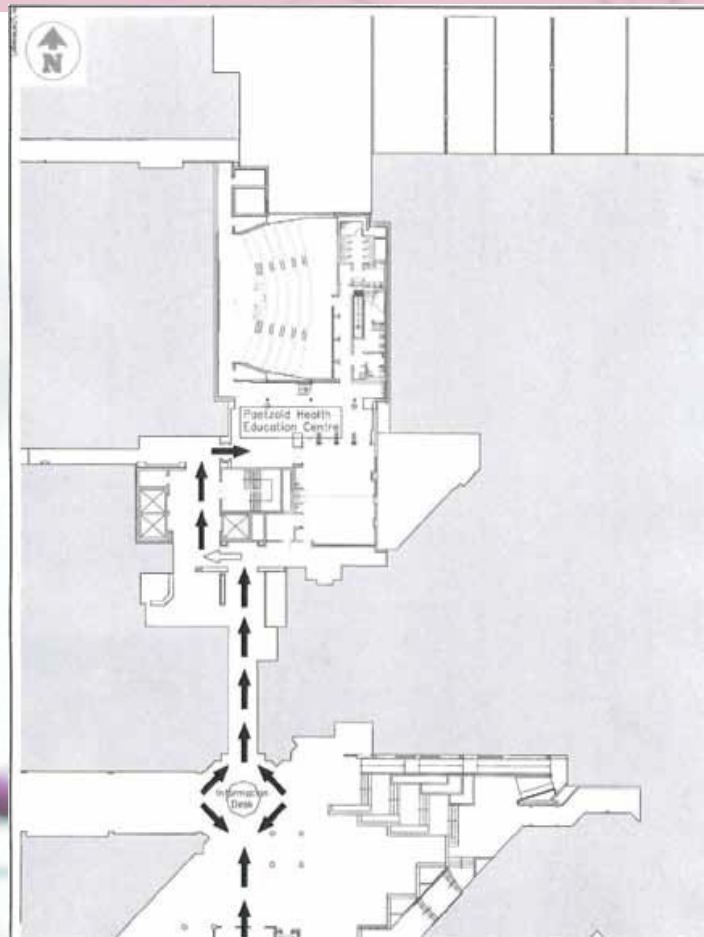
